Points to remember...

- Contact your counsellor if you need any help or have any questions. We are happy to help!
- You are responsible for meeting and keeping track of your grad requirements, but we are here to help you figure it out and stay on track. From grade 10-12, you will receive a Grad Progress Report with each report card.
- If you are unsure about which Math 10 course to take, you will want to consider your grade 9 Math mark (should be C or higher if you plan to take F&P Math) and your post-secondary plans. Talk with your current Math teacher or contact your CSS counsellor.

- Make sure to hand in your course selection form into the QJS main office by Thursday, March 14th.
- Schedules will go out with report cards in June. Contact your Counsellor as soon as possible to make changes to your schedule.
- Counsellors are out of their offices June 29-August 25th but you can email us anytime and we will respond when we are back during the week of August 26th if you want to make any further changes before school starts.
- If you wait until the first day of school to make changes to your schedule, be ready to wait up to 5-6 school days for those changes to be made!
