# Application

---

Requirements:

- be under the age of 19 at the start of school in September of their graduation year
- be a Canadian Citizen, temporary or permanent resident
- be enrolled in a minimum of 3 Post Secondary courses

Other:

- all awards will be paid to accredited institutions unless otherwise specified
- recipients will be notified at Graduation with a detailed letter on how/when to obtain funds
  - Students must request their funds from the Scholarship, Bursary or Award donor within the first year of studies. Available time to claim the award is set from September following graduation. Awards can be claimed sooner upon proof of course registration. Awards may be claimed later than stated if permission is obtained from donor directly
- All documents must be in blue or black ink and be legible
- **All required documents must be provided or the application will be voided**

## Financial Documents

If you are applying for any bursaries or awards that state 'financial need' as a requirement, then please provide documents from ONE of the choices below:

1. T4's
    - 2023 or 2024 T4's or CRA Income Tax Returns; pages 2 and 3, showing lines 150-260
  2. If Self Employed
    - The applicable statement of business/professional activities from either 2023 or 2024
    - Self Declaration, if combined amount exceeds \$246,753 (Level 5)
      - *If choosing self declaration please indicate this on page 6*
  3. No Financial documentation will be provided
    - Applicant will automatically be entered as a level 5 income
    - *If choosing self declaration please indicate this on page 6*
- **ONE COPY, of each T4 or Statement of Business/Professional Activities for all parents/common-law partners/guardians/other supporting adults (even if they are living apart) as well as the student (unless choosing #3 above).**
  - **See school principal immediately if there is an issue with obtaining the correct financial documents.**
  - If there has been a recent change of employment within your family, please provide a Record of Employment.
  - ALL Financial documents are viewed only by Liane Kimmie, Scholarship and Bursary Chair, and are treated with the utmost confidentiality. Income is calculated and given a level on a rubric (see below). Donors and Committee only see the level the student falls under – **no totals are ever given**. If there is an issue with financial documents please contact the school Principal immediately.

### SCHOLARSHIP RESUME

Your Scholarship resume is your chance to showcase yourself and your accomplishments to the donors. Be sure to list as many of the following that you can on your resume. A resume **template** is at the end of this document, **we highly recommend you type your resume for submission**.

- Accomplishments/Certificates from Grade 7-12 (Honour Roll, Principals Roll, WHMIS, Food Safe, Babysitting cert, Lifeguarding cert, Awards/Acknowledgements etc.)
- Service and Leadership Experience (Interact Club, Student Council, Rotary, Lions, Ambassador Program etc.)
- Community involvement
- Work Experience and/or Volunteer Work
- Sports/Teams/Groups (Rodeo, Skating, Hockey, Drama, Band, Dancing etc.)

### T4'S AND/OR OTHER STATEMENTS

- Include **ONLY ONE COPY OF EACH** T4 from You, (student), parent(s), supporting adults, guardians, common law parents as stated and outlined above.
  - *If providing T4(s) from West Fraser you must indicate on T4 which Division of West Fraser.*

### TRANSCRIPTS

A transcript will be provided by the school to calculate your GPA.

## □ TWO REFERENCES

- **Teacher Reference** – Only use the Teacher Reference form provided (see attached). The reference form must be returned in a **sealed envelope** for submission to committee. Teacher must sign sealed flap. DO NOT unseal envelope. Applicants are responsible for requesting, picking up and including Teacher Reference Forms.
- **Local Community Member** – Letter of reference can be emailed but a copy of the original email stating date and time the email was sent MUST be included. Your reference may ***NOT be a direct relative, a secondary school counsellor, a secondary school principal or a member of the Scholarship and Bursary Committee.*** Letter does not need to be in a sealed envelope.

## □ ESSAYS

- **ABSOLUTLEY MUST** be authentic work and thoughts generated by the applicant. AI generated work will not be accepted and applicant will not be considered for the Award.
- Must be typed with the title of the award and the applicants name at the top of the page.
- Do not use staples – make use of headers and/or footers, if you have more than one page.
- Do not double side any documents.

## □ SPECIAL APPLICATION FORMS

- Special application forms are available in the Career Centre.
- Forms must be completed in blue or black ink and be legible.

## □ APPLICATION FORM

- Application form must be completed in Blue or Black Ink, information must be legible, and the awards that are being applied for must be CLEARLY indicated by a check mark or an X
  - Parent/ Guardian and Student must sign application form to be considered for any award
